Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil is the most versatile of all food wrapping materials, as it can withstand both heat and cold. The three most common uses for Reynolds Wrap® are:

Pan Lining

Line baking pans with Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil before you cook to avoid scrubbing afterwards. To line pans easily, turn pan upside down and press a sheet of aluminum foil around it. Remove foil and drop foil inside the pan. Crimp edges of foil to rim of pan.

Packet Cooking

Packet Cooking is a simple way to make great meals. Preparation is easy, no special equipment is necessary and cleanup is a breeze. The appetizing appearance and burst of aroma when you open the foil packets make a great impression.

Covering Food

Use foil as a quick cover for skillets, pans or casserole dishes that have no lids. Covering foods in the oven prevents over-browning and drying out, and covering stovetop pans prevents spattering and messy cleanups. Carefully lift foil with a pot holder when checking or removing food.

There are many other creative ways to use Reynolds Wrap® every day including:

Panini Press

Place a Panini sandwich on medium hot grill. Wrap a brick in foil, place on top of sandwich and grill five minutes on each side. Remember to wear grill mitts when lifting brick.

Grill Scrubbers

Use crumpled pieces of Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil as a scouring pad to clean barbecue grill grates. It is the easiest way to keep your grill clean between uses.

Soften Brown Sugar

To restore your hardened brown sugar to its former granulated glory, break off a piece of hardened sugar, wrap it in foil and bake in the oven at 300° F for five minutes. Use immediately.

Gourmet Chocolate Desserts

Press foil over the back of shells, or other molds. Spread chocolate over items and refrigerate 1-2 hours. Carefully remove item, leaving chocolate on foil. Place chocolate-side down on serving dish; peel off foil.

Keep it Together

Instead of using toothpicks or kitchen twine to keep a stuffed tenderloin from unrolling, for instance, tear a few pieces of Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil off the roll to create quick and durable “ties” that are sturdy yet simple to remove.



Paint Saver

Not only can you save your paint trays by lining them with aluminum foil, you can also save your rollers. Wrap your wet paint roller with Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil to act as a cover that will protect the roller from drying between applications.

Art Projects

Use Reynolds Wrap® Aluminum Foil in art sculpture projects. Crumple foil and use for decorative effects like sponge painting. Use as a background for decorative bulletin boards.

Ironing

Place foil between an ironing board pad and its cover to reflect heat and shorten ironing time. This helps moisten the fabric and removes wrinkles quickly.

Funnel Making

Foil can be shaped into funnels of any size or shape – great to use when pouring into small-mouthed bottles.

Plant Starters

If you are raising seedlings indoors, start the seeds in cups formed of aluminum foil.
